**DM/0084/09: ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION FOR THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF A GALVANIZING PLANT ON PORTION 5 OF ERF 6807 PINETOWN, SITUATED AT 5 SPRITE PLACE, LOCATED WITHIN THE ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY.**

1. The KwaZulu-Natal Department of Agriculture, Environmental Affairs and Rural Development have decided to **authorise** the above-mentioned project. The environmental authorisation and reasons for the decision are attached herewith.
2. Although the application was processed in terms of the 2006 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, sub-regulation 75(2) of the EIA Regulations, 2010, states that any decision issued in terms of the previous (*i.e.* 2006) regulations must be considered under the EIA Regulations, 2010. As such, notification of interested and affected parties as well as any appeal process must follow the requirements as set out in the EIA Regulations, 2010.
3. In terms of sub-regulation 10(2) of the EIA Regulations, 2010, you are instructed to notify all registered interested and affected parties in writing within **twelve (12) days** of this Department's decision in respect of your application. You are required to comply with the requirements of sub-regulations 10(2)(a)-(d) with regard to this notification. This includes drawing the attention of registered interested and affected parties to the fact that an appeal may be lodged against the decision in terms of Chapter 7 of the EIA Regulations, 2010.
